# TEAM COMPETITION

Over the past few seasons, the club has been fielding about a dozen tennis teams across the Sussex, Weald and Horam leagues.

- **Sussex leagues are the most competitive leagues in the area and one of the largest doubles leagues in Great Britain. They include Men's and Women's events and cover both East & West Sussex. Each league features about a dozen divisions, with the lower divisions (usually Div5 and below) further split between East & West.**
- **Weald leagues feature teams located between the North & South Downs (across Sussex, Surrey and Kent). They include Men's, Women's and Mixed events. Each league has up to 6 divisions.**
- **Both Sussex and Weald leagues run Winter and Summer seasons separately, i.e., promotions/relegations in one given season will only impact the same season of the following year.**
- **The Horam mixed league is a Summer league aimed at promoting friendly competition among local clubs.**
